Greeters & Ushers*

Greeters welcome guests with a warm hello and a smile and help new visitors when needed.

Greeters serve on Sunday mornings and at special events.

Ushers have a two-fold responsibility: to man the doors at all gatherings to ensure safety for all and to guide attendees to seats.

Children's Ministry*

These roles include Nursery and Toddler care, Sunday School teachers, Truth Trackers & Children's Church teachers during worship, prayer and other gatherings. For the safety of our young ones, all adults working in children's ministries will go through intensive training and background checks.

Music Ministry*

Includes vocalists for the different music groups, musicians for worship services and administrative support.

Audio-Visual, Website, Photography

Members of the AV team run lighting and sound for all gatherings and special events. Other folks produce images/videos for the website, publicity and historical archives.

Grounds & Facilities Care

These many teams mow the lawn, shovel snow, manage repairs, organize "congregation work days" and clean the interior of the building weekly.

Fellowship & Outreach Events

From VBS to blood drives, and all fellowship activities in between. These folks get involved in the many aspects of community service activities that vary from year to year. Activities include cooking, hosting, setup/tear down, parking, and whatever needs to be done.

Administrative & Financial*

There are both weekly, monthly and seasonal activities in this area that require experienced support.
